You are hereby required either to:

(a) Revoke your January 11, 1996 order, permitting plaintiff's
representative to introduce evidence regarding plaintiff's emotional distress
damages at trial, in Los Angeles County Superior Court case No. BC090848,
entitled PATRICIA CORDOVA v. COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES et al., and enter
a new and different order, precluding plaintiff's representative from introducing
evidence regarding plaintiff's emotional distress damages at trial; or

(b) In the alternative

SHOW CAUSE before this court, in its courtroom at 300 South Spring Street, Third Floor, Los Angeles, California, on May 28, 1996, at 9 a.m., why a peremptory writ of mandate ordering you to do so should not issue.

If respondent court chooses to comply with alternative (a), then a certified copy of the minute order showing compliance shall be filed with this court on or before April 1, 1996.

The written return in opposition to the writ shall be served and filed on or before April 19, 1996.

Any reply to the opposition shall be served and filed on or before May 3, 1996.
